Introduction to tax

Sign up and join us for an online informative meeting about how to **pay tax in Norway**. This is useful if you are moving to Norway, shifting between Norway and other working countries, or working from abroad. We have this seminar **2 Fridays per month**, from **11.00** to **11.30**. The next seminar will be on April 19th. In the registration form you can choose which date you want to sign up to.

Understanding Norway: Culture, work life and well-being

Dual career: career advice for partners

If your partner came with you to Norway, and they are looking for a job, this course will be useful for them to get to know the basics about the Norwegian labor market, how to prepare a CV and cover letter, and a bit about Norwegian culture. As the date is not confirmed yet, we will ask you to <u>sign up to this form</u> so we can send you more information about it.

Check your tax return for 2023

Your tax return for 2023 will be available for review during this month and the deadline to hand it in is April 30th.

Make sure to check that your tax information is correct: Tax Administration.

You will need MinID or BankID to access the assessment and you can order it here.

Note that the PIN codes and information will go to the address registered in Folkeregisteret.

Remember that if you have been on the PAYE scheme during 2023, you will not receive a tax return; you will receive a receipt in June for PAYE paid tax.

Is your time in Norway coming to an end?

If your position is ending and you're preparing to leave Norway, there are several important steps to take care of. These include notifying the National Registry, updating your postal address, closing bank accounts if necessary, and ensuring you have the correct tax information for your final assessment. Important information about holidays as a UiB employee:

As a UiB employee, you are entitled to 5 weeks of holiday per year. However, during your first year of employment in Norway, your holiday days will be unpaid holiday days. This means that while you have the right to take holidays, they will not be paid and the days you decide to take will be deducted from your salary on the month that you are taking them.

If you wish to access your paid holiday days in advance from the upcoming year, you can apply for this option. Please contact your immediate supervisor or head of administration for further information.

Make sure to upload your holidays in the self-service portal before 1st of May.
